October 2024 NPQs

Thank you to all teachers and leaders who have secured a scholarship funded place on our October 2024 starting NPQ programmes.

We were allocated more places that most providers, but this was still only 118 places.

All of the scholarship funded places for this October have now gone and we have many teachers on waitlists.


